

WHAT IS EARLY INTERVENTION?

Early intervention involves identifying and providing specialized supports for children who show signs of developmental delays or challenges in the early years of life.

- This includes difficulty with speech and language development, social-emotional skills, both fine motor and gross motor movements, and more.
- Identifying these needs early in life is crucial for Early Intervention because the main goal is to provide timely assistance (preferably before the age of 3) in order to maximize a child's potential.



WHY IS EARLY INTERVENTION SO IMPORTANT?



- 1) **Critical Windows:** Research on brain development has found that most of a human's major brain structures are in place by age 3. Early Intervention utilizes this period of rapid growth and learning to foster essential skills while the brain is most receptive to skill development.
- 2) **Building Strong Foundations:** By addressing concerns early on, we help children build a strong foundation for future learning, social interactions, and emotional well-being. This sets them up for long term success!
- 3) **Improving Social and Emotional Skills:** Early support helps children develop better communication and social skills, enabling them to build positive relationships and navigate social situations with confidence.
- 4) **Preventing Future Challenges:** When issues are identified and managed early on, children are less likely to face significant challenges later in life, including academic struggles and behavioral issues.
- 5) **Supporting Families:** Early intervention services also guide and support families, equipping them with the tools and resources needed to nurture their child's growth.
